The Expected Standard

Children are at the expected standard when they achieve a scaled score of 100 or more, calculated from their test score.

How many children met the expected standard in all three subjects?

67% of children in school achieved the expected standard in all three subjects compared to 65% nationally.

Progress Measure

This is a measure of the progress children make between the end of Key Stage 1 (Year 2) to the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6).

Reading	-3.8
Writing	-4.4
Mathematics	-3.6

A score of 0 means pupils in school on average do as well at KS2 as those with similar attainment nationally. A positive score means pupils in this school on average do better at KS2 as those with similar attainment nationally.
