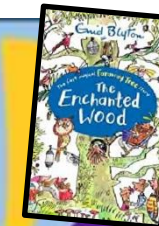

YEAR 2 AUTUMN TERM

AS CREATORS WE ARE.....

ART: In Art we will be creating observational drawings of teddy bears. We will explore a variety of media for drawing, such as pencils, pens, crayons, chalk, pastels, charcoal.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: In DT we will be designing and making our own hand puppets out of felt.

MUSIC: 'You've Got A Friend In Me' - learning and performing songs linked to toys and Toy Story.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION : In PE we will be learning all about kicking! We will explore different ways of kicking objects with increasing accuracy and control.

AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

In maths this term we will be learning about: place value, length and mass, addition and subtraction and 2D and 3D shapes.

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

In English we are going to begin with poetry linked to a nursery rhyme. The children will innovate their own poems and perform them to the rest of the class. We are then going to write our own stories based on the book 'Harry the Happy Mouse'.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: In science we will be learning about Everyday Materials. We will learn to identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....

GEOGRAPHY: In Geography we will be learning to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans. We will be using world maps, atlases and globes to identify the UK and its countries, and we will be looking at the location of hot and cold countries in the world.

HISTORY : In History we will be learning about the history of toys and how they have changed over the years from Victorian times to now.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: In RE we will be learning about Harvest. We will be thinking about why we celebrate Harvest and where our food comes from. We will later link this to Judaism and explore the Jewish festival of Sukkot.

AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE.....

COMPUTING: We will continue introducing skills around extending control by exploring remote control cars and how these can be controlled with simple instructions.

AS YOUNG PEOPLE WE ARE...

We will be looking at relationships and thinking what is the same and what is different about each of us. Then moving on to think about people who are special to us.
