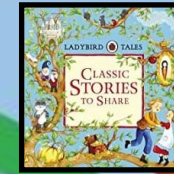

EARLY YEARS AUTUMN TERM

AS CREATORS WE ARE.....

ART: In Art we will be creating drawings of our favourite toy. We will explore a variety of media for drawing, such as pencils, pens, crayons, chalk, pastels, charcoal. We will also be printing our own Christmas wrapping paper.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: I wonder if my family is like yours? In DT we will be making simple models of different kinds of homes.

MUSIC: I wonder why people give gifts? In music we will be learning and performing songs together, focusing on nursery Rhymes and Christmas Songs.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION : In PE we will be learning all about kicking! We will explore different ways of kicking objects with increasing accuracy and control.

AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

...learning about number and shapes by matching, sorting, comparing size, length, amounts and exploring patterns.

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

...we will be working hard with our phonics. We will also be doing lots of mark marking, name writing and listening and responding to a range of stories. We will then move on to write our own Christmas lists and instructions for how to make Christmas cookies! Yum!

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: I wonder what changes in Autumn? I wonder where light comes from? In Science, we will begin by exploring the immediate world around us and use our senses to observe the changes that happen in autumn. We will then move on to explore where light comes from.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....

GEOGRAPHY: I wonder what changes in Autumn? The children will be exploring their immediate locality and community as we explore the immediate world around us this term - including regular outdoor visits and walks.

HISTORY : I wonder if my family is like yours. We begin to make sense of the children's own life-story. Understand the ways they have changed. Talk about the changes that have happened within their family lifetime e.g. talking to grandparents about holiday etc... Talk about changes that happen over a short period of time.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: We will be looking at how we are all unique and special.

AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE.....

COMPUTING: We will be focusing upon our fine motor skills by finger drawing on iPads and using early painting tools.

AS YOUNG PEOPLE WE ARE...

We will be concentrating this term upon how we meet new friends by participating and sharing and how we can become confident at working on our own. We will also be looking at how everyone's family may be different and understand that every one who looks after us is different in their own ways.
