AS CREATORS WE ARE.....

ART: Drawings– The Art of Ancient Greece. We will be looking at the different art forms in Ancient Greece and we will be concentrating on how to draw human forms, incorporating colour mixing and sketching techniques

AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

Year 5 will be focusing on place value, addition and subtraction, statistics, geometry and measures.

Year 6 will be focusing on place value, decimals, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

We will be reading 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe'. This is a fantasy novel that has exciting vocabulary, events and characters in it.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: Properties and Changes of Materials- Compare and group based upon hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity (electrical and thermal), and response to magnets. Then moving onto a wider study reversible and irreversible changes.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....

GEOGRAPHY: Volcanoes– in this topic we will look at how the earth is made, how a volcano is formed,, how it erupts, where are they found, how volcanoes affect people and we will take a particular interest in the volcanoes in Greece

HISTORY: Ancient Greece– in this topic we will look at what events took place, Greek life, gods and goddesses, Athens vs Sparta, Alexander the Great and we will briefly look at the Olympic Games

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: The Bible-deepen children's understanding of the importance and impact of the contents of the Bible in the lives of Christians. Children will develop their understanding of the significance of holy books in the lives of the people of all world faith
Advent– children will delve deeper into the themes of the season of Advent and pupils will be introduced to the Christian belief that Jesus will return (the second coming)

AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE.....

COMPUTING: Coding– children will learn how to code efficiently, simulate a physical system, use functions, introduce strings, use text variables and concatenation

FRENCH: Children will learn how to say where they live, talk about rooms In there house. Children will also learn how to say a variety of food and drink and understand how change a singular noun to plural. Towards the end of the term, children will name some WW2 countries in French.
