AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

...learning about:
**Place value, Multiplications, Fractions,
 Division, Volume, Capacity & Mass**

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

To start the term we will be looking at The Iron Man by Ted Hughes, using this to enhance our writing and grammar skills.
We will then be creating our Iron Man adventure stories when writing to entertain. We will then be write diaries in the role of the character.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: Forces. Studying the different types of forces. For example, friction and magnets. We will link this to our topic on Ancient Greece by investigation the different forces they used or crested.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....

GEOGRAPHY: We will investigate why London is the capital city of The United Kingdom. This will include locating London on the map, looking at the

AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE.....

COMPUTING: Touch typing, looking at typing and keyboard skills.

AS CREATORS WE ARE.....

ART: We will be exploring landscapes. Looking at landscapes from Ancient Greece in comparison with local landscapes.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: We will be creating structures linked to Ancient Greece. These might be temples, hypostyle halls, open-air theaters, public squares, or residential models.

MUSIC: Composing using imagination.—The children will compose their own music, thinking about tone, pulse and rhythm.

More musical styles—We will explore a range of music including Reggae, Pop, Soul and Film.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION : This term we will be doing Dance based on our topic The Iron Man. On Tuesdays, AFC Fylde will be in working with the children.
