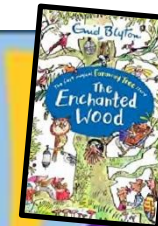

SPRING TERM KS1

AS CREATORS WE ARE.....

ART: We will be developing our colour mixing skills and learning about the work of artist Romare Bearden. We will then create textured papers using paint and compose our own collages inspired by exploring colour and texture in the world around us.

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY: We will be exploring different textiles by designing, making and decorating a pouch using a template. We will learn how to sew a running stitch.

MUSIC: We will be exploring how to invent a musical story and recognising different sounds.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: We will be working on our fundamental skills through playground games in the 20th century.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: Uses of Everyday Materials-We will be recognising the suitability of materials for specific purposes and exploring how actions like stretching and bending can affect solid objects

Comparing Animals-We will be learning about animals, comparing and grouping them by similarities and differences in characteristics, physical features and diets.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....

HISTORY: We will be sequencing toys into a physical timeline and investigating artefacts from the past. We will learn how teddy bears have changed and 'interview' an old teddy bear before considering what toys might be like in the future.

GEOGRAPHY: We will be locating the countries of the UK on a map and using directional language to explore the location of features on maps. We will then create our own map using symbols to represent features and places on the school grounds.
