

# Weeton St Michael's School Uniform and P.E Kit

## Boys:

Pale blue short sleeve shirt and tie/polo shirt \*

School sweatshirt \*

Grey tailored trousers or shorts

Grey or black socks

Black shoes



## Girls:

Pale blue short sleeved blouse and tie / polo shirt\*

School sweatshirt or school cardigan\*

Grey tunic or grey skirt (knee length)

White socks (or grey tights in cold weather)

Flat, black shoes

Tailored grey trousers only (no bootleg/stretch material etc)

Summer Term : Blue & white summer dress.



## PE Kit:

Girls and Boys Infants and Juniors

Navy shorts ( knee length)

School T shirt\*

Black pumps (not trainers)

Plain jogging bottoms and hoodie during colder weather (No logos)

Drawstring Pump bag-(available from school in September)\*



## Jewellery

We do not encourage jewellery, but if earrings need to be worn to school, they must be “studs” (as rings and any form of dangling earrings are dangerous.) Children must be able to remove and replace earrings themselves for PE. For children who have recently had their ears pierced and cannot remove their earrings they will be asked to bring plasters to be put over their earrings themselves. (This is in accordance with LCC guidelines). Watches may be worn at owner’s risk. No other jewellery should be worn.

## Naming Clothing

All items should be named please. This is for parents as well as staff, as it is easier to rehome lost items if they are named.

## Hair

All long hair must be tied back, bobbles etc to be in appropriate colours. Sensible smart hair cuts. (No tram lines, spikes etc.) No hair gel, or coloured hair, make up or nail varnish.

## School Bag\*

School book bags are required due to the limited space in the classrooms and cloakrooms.



## Non participants

Please note that PE is a National Curriculum subject and therefore a compulsory school subject. If your child is to be excused for medical reasons then a note must be brought in to this effect. If a child refuses to participate in any way, the parent/carer may be called to take them home.
