the Diary:

My child has tested positive for COVID-19 - How long do they have to stay away from school for?

All people (staff and pupils) have to isolate for a minimum of 5 full days following a positive test before returning to school if they test negative on day 5 and the morning of day 6, providing they do not have a temperature. If either test is positive, they should continue to isolate until they have two consecutive negative LFD results or until they have completed 10 full days of isolation, whichever is the earliest.

Thankyou so much for bearing with us with all the changes in regulations and for following the guidance. We currently do have staff and children isolating with symptoms or because they have tested positive for COVID-19.

Together we will ensure our children and staff stay safe.
